
<u>Aligned</u> with the Science of Teaching Reading

Language acquisition is <u>natural</u>. Reading acquisition is <u>taught</u>.

- <u>Explicit instruction</u> from a teacher focused on how sounds and print are related is <u>key</u> to reading.
- Early text reading opportunities <u>align with phonics instruction</u>.
- Quality literature is a <u>necessary component</u> of a well-rounded reading program.
- "<u>Do not wait</u>."



Mississippi Department of Education Focus: Tier 1

Literacy Based Promotion Act of 2013 Prioritized reading by the end of 3rd grade.

School Leaders

Mississippi Principal Corp provides literacy training, resources, and support to reinforce reading instruction **In-Service Teachers**

Free training on the science of reading to all K-3 teachers. Most schools required their teachers to attend. Pre-Service Teachers

Free training on the science of reading for teacher candidates in colleges and teacher preparation programs



Results of Efforts Focused on Tier 1 Reading Instruction

2017-2019 Gains

- 1st in nation
 - 4th grade reading
 - 4th grade math
- 3rd in nation
 - 8th grade math
- 4th in nation
 - 8th grade reading



 Exceed national average for proportion of students with disabilities at or above proficient in 4th grade
